

## July 2016 Monthly traffic update

**13.3%** International passengers (excluding transit passengers) increased by 13.3% to 791,077 in July 2016, compared with July 2015. The 92,000 increase was driven by the Americas (+31.2%) and Asia/Middle East (+26.4%), with the addition of four new services to each region in July 2016. Solid performances were also achieved by the Pacific (+8.7%) and Tasman (+4.5%) regions, both boosted by school holiday traffic and new airlines serving Rarotonga, the Gold Coast and Cairns.

**171,406** International visitor arrivals increased by 16% to 171,406 in July 2016, mainly due to a 25% increase in holiday arrivals. Seat capacity additions across all key regions have helped drive this growth, accommodating stronger demand during the traditionally lower winter season. Auckland Airport's tourism marketing initiative Four Seasons Five Senses is also helping to create demand and fill this capacity throughout the year, supporting tourism operators, travel agents and airlines to promote outstanding New Zealand seasonal travel experiences.

**12.5%** New Zealand resident departures were up 12.5% in July 2016 due to strong holiday (+13,100 passengers) and visiting friends and relatives (+10,220 passengers) segments. The most popular destination for these travellers was Australia (+5.2%), however we also saw increasing demand for long-haul destinations, including China (+19.1%), the United States (+23.5%), Indonesia (+42.9%), India (+74.4%) and Vietnam (+51.7%). New Zealand residents have made over 2 million overseas trips from Auckland Airport in the past year, an annual increase of 6.2%.

**36.2%** United States visitor arrivals were up 36.2% in July 2016. This growth was stimulated by an additional eleven weekly return services to the United States in July, including American Airlines' daily Los Angeles service, and United Airlines' three-flights-per-week San Francisco service. Arrivals to New Zealand from the Mid-west and East Coast states were up 76.1% in July 2016 as a result of the increased connectivity through these two West Coast airline hubs, as well as Air New Zealand's five-flights-per-week Houston service.
