NOTE: ALL STAFF AT ALL TIMES MUST:

SNEEZE OR COUGH INTO ELBOW. PERFORM HAND HYGIENE IMMEDIATELY AFTER COUGHING OR SNEEZING.
MAINTAIN 2M PHYSICAL DISTANCING FROM GUESTS WHEREVER POSSIBLE. KEEP INTERACTIONS WITH GUESTS TO A MINIMUM.
UNDERTAKE HAND HYGIENE BY WASHING OR USING ≥60% ALCOHOL-BASED SANITISER MUST BE REGULARLY UNDERTAKEN BY ALL STAFF INCLUDING ESPECIALLY BEFORE AND AFTER:
EATING/ DRINKING; BREAKS; WEARING OR DISPOSING OF PPE; AND IMMEDIATELY AFTER TOUCHING ANY SURFACE OR ITEM OF AN ARRIVING "RED" GUEST
COMPLY WITH BORDER WORKERS COVID-19 TESTING ORDER AND VACCINATION ORDER.
