Aircraft Noise Contours and Overlays


Designation 1100

Noise contours within Designation 1100 *restrict how much* noise Auckland Airport can produce.

- Future Aircraft Noise Contours (FANC) are the maximum level of noise the Airport can generate
- Annual Aircraft Noise Contours (AANC) are the annual prediction of noise for the following 12 months (calculated from October each year) these determine the properties that are eligible for noise mitigation each year

Auckland Unitary Plan Aircraft Noise Overlays

- Overlay in the AUP which control activities sensitive to aircraft noise (ASAN) establishing in proximity to Auckland Airport
- New ASAN in the High Aircraft Noise Area (HANA) is Prohibited
- New ASAN in the Moderate Aircraft Noise Area (MANA) is restricted through a 1:400m² density control



The Noise Mitigation Programme

What is it?


- Auckland Airport offers and installs acoustic attenuation to existing residential properties and educational facilities within the aircraft noise contours.
- Offers are made on an annual basis as aircraft noise reaches properties within the aircraft noise contours. This is determined by the actual aircraft noise contours.

What does it achieve?

 Mitigation packages achieve an internal noise environment of 40 dBA Ldn or less with all windows and doors closed (confirmed by testing).

What is the cost to homeowners?


- HANA 100% paid for by Auckland Airport
- MANA 75% paid for by Auckland Airport / 25% paid for by the homeowner.
- Auckland Airport Community Trust provides assistance to homeowners unable to contribute the remaining 25%



MANA Package Includes

Ventilation, heatpump & rangehood

75% subsidised by Auckland Airport



HANA Package Includes

Ventilation, heatpump, rangehood, ceiling insulation and window/door seals

100% subsidised by Auckland Airport

The Process

ANNC Developed by June/July

ANNC Published on Auckland Airport website, in NZ Herald and Manukau Courier. Also provided to AKL Council

Eligibility letter sent out Aug/Sept –includes invitation to community drop-in information sessions

Homeowner registers interest with Auckland Airport and pre-inspection undertaken to determine best equipment

Installation offer letter sent to homeowner which confirms which equipment will be installed and where


Covenant registered on the property's Certificate of Title
