

March 2011 Monthly traffic update

Total international passenger volumes (incl. T&T) held firm post-earthquake(s) and increased by 1.4%. While traffic declined from Hong Kong, Sydney and Los Angeles in particular, this was offset by increased traffic from Melbourne and Singapore. Jetstar Asia commenced flights to Singapore in March 2011.

International passenger traffic for Queenstown Airport has grown 52.4% over the last 12 months (compared to the previous 12 months). March 2011 alone saw a 77.9% increase over March 2010. Additional Jetstar capacity has contributed significantly to this lift in passenger numbers.

Domestic passenger figures for March 2011 were 0.6% below March 2010. Domestic seat capacity decreased over March 2010 but all domestic carriers experienced passenger volume growth. Domestic passenger traffic at Mackay Airport grew 20.4% over March 2010. This was driven partly by the continued strong performance and positive outlook for the coal industry but also by soft March 2010 results due the global financial crisis.
