

December 2013 Monthly traffic update

745,345	December 2013 international passenger
7 -10,0-10	volumes (excluding transit passengers) at Auckland Airport were the highest ever for a single month. The 745,345 passengers were at least 25,000 greater than the previous record in January 2013 and 4.1% higher than December 2012. The December 2013 result was driven by higher visitor arrivals over summer, as well as people arriving to visit friends and relatives for the Christmas / New Year period.

- **181,207** The week ended 22 December 2013 was the busiest ever week for international passengers at Auckland Airport with 181,207 passenger movements. This exceeded the previous record week, set for the week ended 23 December 2012, by more than 8,000 passengers. The record performance has continued into 2014 with the weekly record already having been eclipsed by the week ending 12 January 2014 which had 181,821 passenger movements.
- **7.5m +** The 12 month period ending 31 December 2013 was the first time that international passengers (excluding transit passengers) exceeded 7.5 million passengers for a 12 month period. 2013 saw visitor arrival growth predominantly from Australia, the United States of America and China, driven mainly by additional route capacity.
- **30.9%** Queenstown Airport had it busiest calendar year on record in 2013 with a 5.1% increase in total passenger movements. The key contributor to the passenger growth was a 30.9% increase in international visitor arrivals. All three trans-Tasman routes (Brisbane, Melbourne and Sydney) experienced double digit growth due to additional capacity added by all four carriers (Air New Zealand, Jetstar, Qantas and Virgin Australia). Qantas has also announced that it will further increase frequency during the 2014 Easter school holidays and peak ski season.
