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## Commitment to Safety and Health

Auckland Airport is committed to developing a safety culture which establishes our company as a benchmark for safety among our peers.

Our vision is to reach a destination of **Zero Harm** to anyone as a result of our operations. To achieve **Zero Harm**, all our managers, employees and contractors need to make good decisions every day, and understand that every person's contribution to safety and health - whatever their role at Auckland Airport - is critical.

Our Safety Management System sets out the formal framework for managing a safe and healthy operation.

Our mind-set is one of continuous learning and improvement, which includes monitoring, measuring and improving our performance over time.

We will have a safety culture where:

- We understand and actively manage risks to aviation and workplace safety, and to people's health;
- Our aim is best practice, and our *minimum* standard is compliance with legal requirements;
- Safety is a core responsibility of our directors, executives, managers, employees and contractors, with each of us committed to playing our part to make this a safe and healthy place to work and visit;
- Safety incidents, concerns and observations are always reported, reviewed, and appropriately acted on;
- Every person is empowered to speak up and take action on safety or health concerns;
- We monitor, measure and report our safety performance, so we can continuously learn and improve.
