- International passenger volumes continued to be positive in January 2008, up 1.6% over the same month last year, and up 3.7% on a 12 month rolling basis.
- International arrivals and departures were both up in January 2008 by 1.9%, and 1.2%, respectively.
- New Zealand resident arrivals were up 1.9% compared to the same period last year, and 7.0% on a 12 month rolling basis.
- Major inbound markets were mixed, with Australia up 7.3%, the United Kingdom down 4.1%, and the United States up 4.0%.
- Canada was up 14.2% for the month and up 6.2% on a 12 month rolling basis.
- Chinese arrivals were up 12.2% for the month, and up 15.9% on a 12 month rolling basis.
- Japanese arrivals were down 18.1% for January 2008 and down 12.8% on a 12 month rolling basis, with Korean arrivals down 14.5% for the month and 12.4% on a 12 month rolling basis.
- Domestic passenger volumes were up strongly at 15.4% compared to the same month last year and up 6.6% on a 12 month rolling basis.
- International aircraft movements and domestic aircraft movements increased in January by 3.6% and 7.6%, respectively. Year to date
 international aircraft movements were the same as last year. However, domestic movements were up 0.8%.
