



## April 2010 Monthly traffic update

7.9%

April 2010 domestic passenger volumes continued to grow strongly. This month Jetstar performed well compared with Qantas in April 2009 while Pacific Blue and Air New Zealand also grew passenger numbers.

-3.0%

Australian arrivals show a decline versus April 2009 mainly driven by the earlier timing of Australian school holidays. The combined growth for March and April 2010 was 6.2%.

**Flat** 

International passenger volumes were flat in April against the corresponding period last year despite European long haul travel being impacted by restrictions on flight movements due to volcanic ash.

Korean arrivals increased on the back of 24.5% increases in seat availability in the South Korean market.
