

## February 2014 Monthly traffic update

- 8.4% International passenger volumes (excluding transit passengers) were 8.4% greater in February 2014 than the previous year. There were 50,000 more international passengers than February 2013. The majority of the passenger growth came on Trans-Tasman routes which had more than 30,000 additional passengers. Passenger volumes on North America routes also continued to track well above last year, with 10,000 additional passengers.
- 8 million Total international passengers movements (including transits) have exceeded 8 million for the first time in a 12 month period. In the 12 months ending February 2014 total passenger volumes were 4.7% higher than the previous period, an increase of more than 350,000 passenger movements.
- **12.4%** Monthly visitor arrivals from Australia were up 12.4% in February 2014. Australian arrivals have been one of the strongest markets in the last 12 months, with the largest actual visitor arrival increase (more than 50,000 visitor arrivals). This strong performance has encouraged the introduction of new services, such as to Adelaide and Perth, as well as increased capacity on east coast trunk routes through additional services and larger aircraft.
- **13.2%** The earlier timing of Chinese New Year (late January this year compared with mid-February last year) resulted in fewer visitor arrivals from China in February 2014. While visitor arrivals from China were down 10.7% compared to February 2013, when Chinese arrivals for January and February are combined we see a 13.2% increase (6,326 passengers) on 2013.
