



## September 2014 Monthly traffic update

International passenger volumes (excluding transit passengers) at Auckland Airport were up 1.4% versus September 2013. The majority of the growth came from Tasman (+4,000 passengers) and Pacific routes (+3,500 passengers). Tasman growth was fuelled by increased capacity including the Emirates A380 on Dubai-Brisbane-Auckland route. Pacific growth was mainly driven by Air New Zealand services to Nadi and Port Vila.

Visitor arrivals from South America were up 32.6% in September 2014 compared to the previous year. LAN Airlines has stimulated this growth by moving to daily services between Auckland and Santiago, a 38.6% increase in flights. This additional capacity combined with a recent Tourism New Zealand campaign promoting New Zealand as an education destination to Brazilian travellers has helped grow Brazilian arrivals by 55.9% versus September 2013.

The upcoming Summer peak will see an extra 140,000 seats added on Asian routes from November to March. This 15% increase in capacity serves demand from our high-growth markets in China and South East Asia. China Southern increases to double daily 787-8 flights to Guangzhou, China Eastern launches a new seasonal service to Shanghai and Cathay Pacific will extend its second daily service to Hong Kong until mid-March 2015 due to strong demand. Singapore Airlines upgauges to an A380 on its daily flight to Singapore and Air New Zealand will resume daily flights to Singapore from January 2015 as part of its new alliance with Singapore Airlines.

Asian inbound markets performed well in September 2014. Visitor arrivals from Thailand were up 40.5%, Indonesia arrivals were up 31.3% and arrivals from Taiwan were up 23.2%. While Chinese visitor arrivals were lower in September 2014 compared to a strong September 2013, dual travel was sold heavily prior to the introduction of new travel regulations last October. The market has since adjusted to these changes and Chinese arrivals have grown 4% this financial year with a strong start for the next quarter.
