AUCKLAND AIRPORT – CONDITIONS OF USE PROCEDURE FOR MOVING / REMOVING AIRCRAFT

In the event that we are required to move/remove an aircraft as a result of a failure by you to comply with an instruction from us to you under these Conditions to do so:

- 1. We will, where applicable, follow the procedures for the recovery of disabled aircraft set out in our Aerodrome Emergency Plan Manual and other relevant operational instructions.
- 2. In other cases, we will provide you with as much notice as is, in all the circumstances, reasonably practicable:
 - (a) that we intend to move/remove the aircraft;
 - (b) of the proposed location to which the aircraft is to be relocated;
 - (c) of the means by which we intend to move/remove the aircraft; and
 - (d) of any other conditions which may apply to your recovery of the aircraft.
- 3. In the event that the notice referred to in paragraph 2 is not practicable we will notify you, as soon as possible:
 - (a) that we have moved/removed the aircraft;
 - (b) of the location to which the aircraft has been moved; and
 - (c) of any conditions which may apply to your recovery of the aircraft.
